

Turner Field Stadium Neighborhoods

The Turner Field Stadium Neighborhoods Corridor is bounded by Interstate 20 on the north, Grant Terrace on the east, the Atlanta and West Point Railroad line on the south and Metropolitan Parkway on the west. The Corridor includes six subareas as follows:

- Turner Field/Georgia Avenue (same as Georgia Ave/RDA)
- Mechanicsville Commercial (same as Georgia Ave/RDA)
- McDaniel Glenn (same as Georgia Ave/RDA)
- Ralph David Abernathy Boulevard at Metropolitan Parkway (same as Georgia Ave/RDA)
- University Avenue Intersection
- Milton Avenue/Ridge Street

These demographics exclude the McDaniel Glenn, RDA at Metropolitan Parkway, University Avenue and Milton Avenue/Ridge Street subareas, which are part of the proposed BeltLine TAD.
